DB Cargo runs 20 trains on the north-south-north and east-west-east axes for DHL Freight as an overnight express service

- Highest priority express train paths and speeds of up to 140km/h guarantee reliable next morning deliveries
- A comprehensive weekend network completes the portfolio and underlines the competitive advantage over road transport
- 6 million additional parcel shipments a year via special train services during the Christmas season

- Work to expand with a second terminal module is in progress







Resources for robust concepts

- Large fleet of locomotives: 1,200 electric locomotives, of which more than 700 operate cross-border services
- Investments in our main north-south corridor:
 60 new multi-system locomotives for the transports in 6 countries (Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Italy, Netherlands, Belgium). More such locomotives to be procured in 2023 and subsequent years
- Deployment of 44 multi-system locomotives for the corridors towards eastern and southeastern Europe
- 25% of own fleet fitted with ETCS
- Reliable, energy-efficient and cross-border traction

- Latest fleet: 1,600 double pocket wagons in total, around
 1,300 double pocket wagons for megatrailers
- 7,300 intermodal wagons will be equipped with GPS by the end of 2023

- Comprehensive wagon service
- Wagon dispatching on selected European corridors
- Own damaged wagon management at key terminals
- Mobile maintenance
- Additional services, such as monitoring of trainset movements and trainset compositions
- Further e-services in the pipeline





- Extensive network through cooperation with partners from/to
 Rotterdam and Antwerp, as well as cooperation with leading domestic
 terminals more than 672 shuttle trains per week in Europe
- Containers are transported from Rotterdam and Antwerp to the most important European economic centres via the Duisburg and Neuss hubs. Trucks to the final destination complete the rail transports, e.g. Quirinus-Express, 9 per week

Terminals, depots and trucking - DB Intermodal Services

Operates at 13 locations with depot services and trucking



Depot services for loaded and empty containers: **close-to-terminal storage capacity of 37,000 TEU** – for relieving pressure on transhipment terminals and ports

Plant logistics – transport services in inter-plant transport for automotive manufacturers

Trucking – container deliveries for seaport hinterland transport by road between transhipment terminal, depot and customer; depot-to-depot positioning also offered

Services for load units – repair, maintenance, cleaning, container sales, etc.



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
